**Subject: Expansion of refinery capacity from 7.5 MMTPA to 7.8 MMTPA of Bharat Oman Refineries Limited (BORL) at Bina, MP considering an increase in annual operating days from 333 days to 345 days and maintaining the same daily processing rate -- Amendment in Environmental clearance reg.**

Sir,

This has reference to your letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2015, wherein you have informed that during detailed feasibility studies for the project, the crude refining capacity was marginally increased from 7.5 MMTPA to 7.8 MMTPA for project viability consideration. The crude refining capacity will be increased from 7.5 MMTPA to 7.8 MMTPA by increasing the annual operating days from 333 to 345 days without any change in the daily processing rate considering increased reliability of refinery operations.

2.0 The proposal was considered by the Reconstituted Expert Appraisal Committee (Industry) in its 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting held during 20<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2015. EIA report preparation/public hearing was exempted as per para 7 (ii) of EIA Notification, 2006. The Committee recommended the proposal for amendment in environmental clearance.


